

If you are having trouble using a USB flash drive containing U3 software on a school computer, uninstall the U3 software to avoid any configuration problems.

You must be at a computer where you have full administrator rights in order to remove U3 from your flash drive. Faculty and student login accounts do not have administrator rights. Please see a lab assistant if you have any questions.

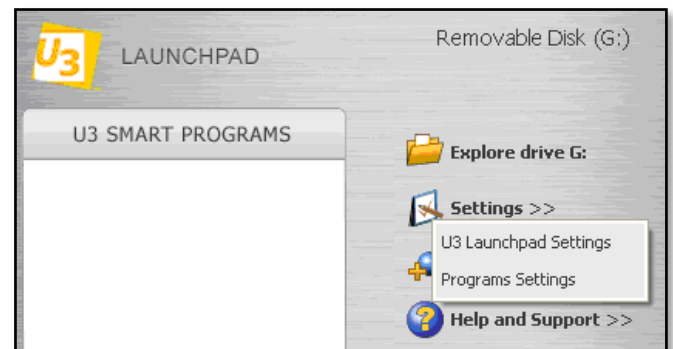
These are generic instructions for removing U3 software from your U3 enabled flash drive. Directions and images may differ slightly from drive to drive. These steps below were tested using a San Disk USB flash drive on a Windows XP computer.

1. Insert your flash drive into a USB port on an appropriate computer and wait for U3 software to load completely.

2. Left mouse-click on the U3 icon in the System Tray in the lower right hand corner of the screen.

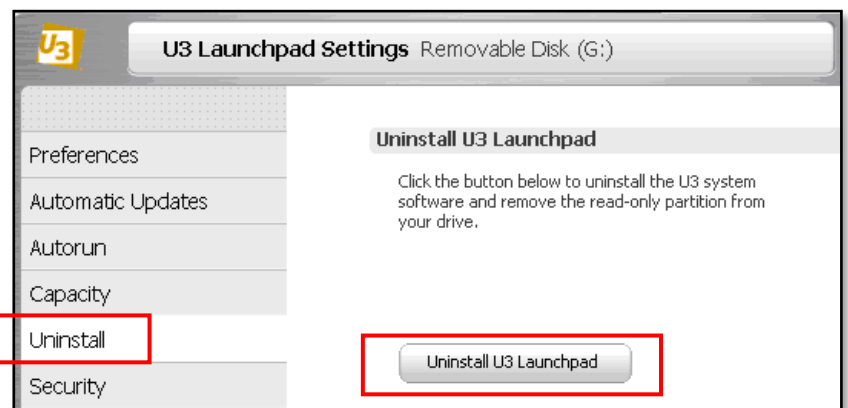


3. On the U3 LaunchPad, point to *Settings* and click on *U3 LaunchPad Settings*.

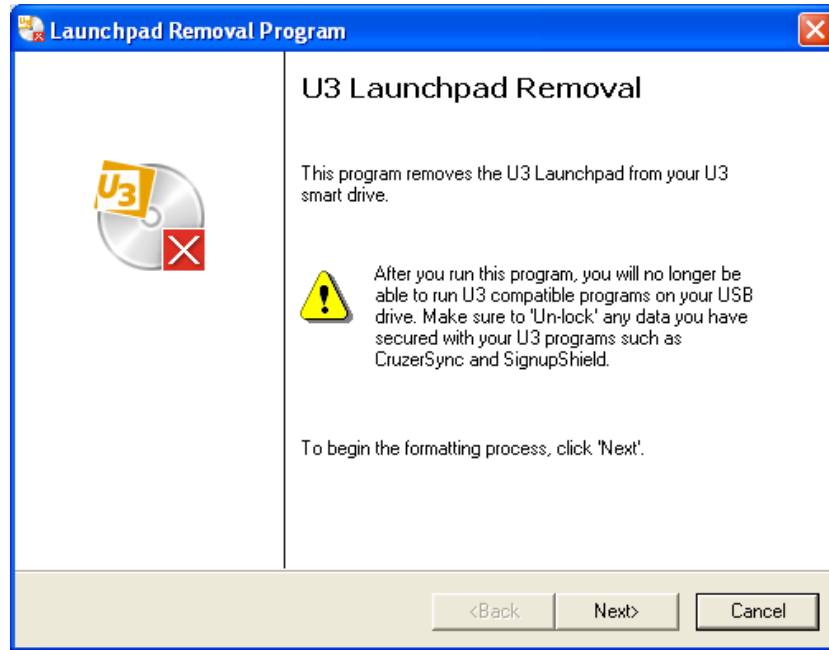


4. Click on *Uninstall* from the *U3 LaunchPad Settings* menu.

5. Left mouse-click on the *Uninstall U3 LaunchPad* button.

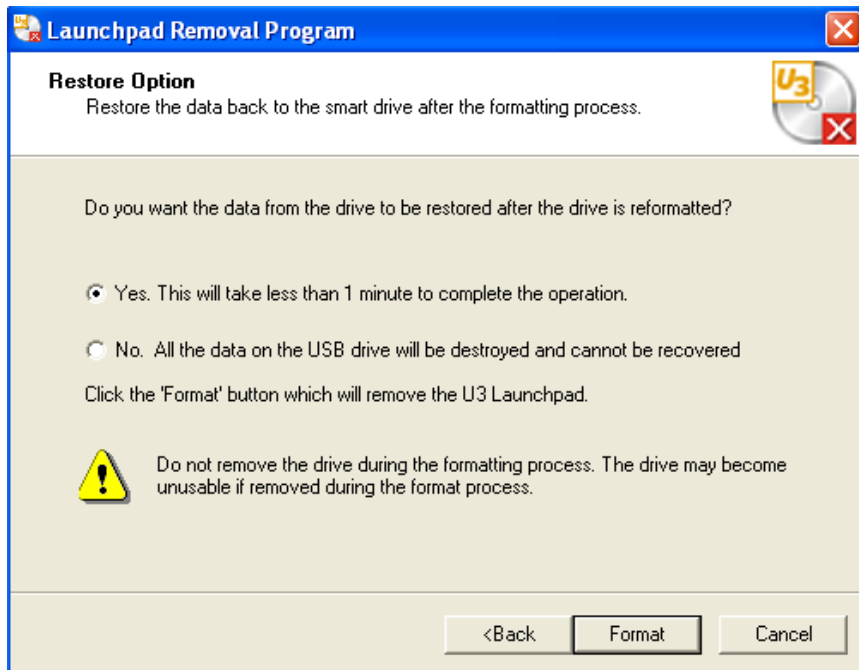


6. Click the *Next* button when the *U3 Launchpad Removal Program* appears.



Formatting will erase all data contained on your flash drive. In order to retain and restore the data currently on your flash drive, make sure that you select Yes in the following dialog box.

7. Decide which formatting option you wish to perform and click the *Format* button.



8. When the U3 Launchpad removal is complete, click the *Done* button. You will now be able to use your drive as a traditional flash drive.
